Galatians 5:16-25 NOTES



THE WARFARE BETWEEN THE SPIRIT & THE FLESH

Galatians 5:16-25 (NASB)

- ¹⁶ But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.
- ¹⁷ For **the flesh sets its desire** against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please. ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Holy Spirit, you are not under the Law [because you are in Christ].
- Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, ²¹ envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.
- VERSE 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.
- ²⁴ Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.
- ²⁵ If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit.

Dr. Tony Evans, "To walk by the Spirit is to discover God's view on a matter, decide to act on that divine perspective, and depend on the Holy Spirit to empower your obedience. Notice that walking by the Spirit doesn't mean resting while the Spirit does all the work ... We are called "to walk" while trusting in the Spirit's empowerment."

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| Dr. Evans also remarks, "It's also important to note that **Paul does not say we won't have desires of the flesh. It's just that walking by the Spirit keeps us from yielding to those desires. **Notice that you don't seek to address the sinful desires of the flesh first. You focus on walking by the Spirit first and He overrides – not necessarily cancels [but overrides] – the desires of the flesh. | | | |
